The Health Sector Information, Analysis and Reporting Division (HSIAR) set the foundation for the delivery of high-quality health sector information, analytics and reporting. The Division leads the overarching provincial analytic strategy and approach, and performs comprehensive, integrated analysis of health sector performance to ensure a consistent and timely approach health system measurement utilizing a client centred approach

This role leads and direct the development, implementation and evaluation of major long-term projects from original concepts through final completion. The Senior Manager, Performance Analysis is responsible for the semi-annual production of the Provincial Report and Integrated System Measurement (PRISM) and generating insights on how to achieve system improvements, using statistical best practices, and methodologies. The Senior Manager, Performance Analysis will lead planning, development and engagement work for the project with stakeholders. The role will also include supervisory and team leadership responsibilities.

Qualifications for this role include:

- PhD or Master's degree in Statistics, Economics, Social Sciences, Health Science Administration, or related field plus **3 years** of recent, related experience* **OR**
- Degree in Statistics, Economics, Social Sciences, Health Science Administration, or related field plus **5 years** of recent, related experience*

- Experience managing high priority projects with high public profiles and divergent stakeholder issues.
- Experience preparing statistical and/or analytical written reports for varying non-technical audiences.
