The Primary Care Division is responsible for setting provincial direction to support a high functioning primary health-care system that meets the needs of all British Columbians. This includes leading reforms that support primary care as the foundation of a full-service, community-based, integrated system of person and family-centred care. One which has a focus on improving attachment to primary care providers and access to quality evidence-based services.

In this important role, you will be responsible for building relationships with primary care partners and guiding partners in planning and implement primary care networks in the region. You will be an effective communicator and possess strong collaboration and negotiation skills. You are able to handle changing situations, emerging priorities and challenging deadlines as you work to build positive relationships with other teams and regional staff, cross-ministry partners and stakeholders on projects and policy development. You possess excellent communication skills and are highly skilled at project direction, management and leadership.

Qualifications for this role include:

- Bachelor's Degree or higher in a relevant discipline such as, Business Administration, Health Administration, Social Services or Public Administration. An equivalent combination of education, training, and experience may be considered.
- Three (3) years or more of demonstrated experience in each of the following areas:
 - o community development,
 - o project management, and/or
 - o business case development.
- Experience with Patient and Public Engagement
- Experience in establishing relationships with multiple external stakeholders/partners.
- Experience establishing collaborative relationships and leading change.
- Experience negotiating agreements and working collaboratively in partnership arrangements.
- Experience in a supervisory/management role including resolving complex staff and/or client issues.
