The ideal candidate possesses significant leadership and management experience in health-related programs and service delivery. In addition to technical experience, you are passionate about health equity and committed to listening to the needs of the community to provide effective public health services. Your strong relationship-building skills contribute to developing effective partnerships and collaborations, while ensuring the administrative, financial, and organizational integrity of the department. Requirements include a Medical Degree with a current license to practice medicine in the province of Ontario from the CPSO with a FRCP designation, as well as a master's in health sciences or Public Health.
