The ideal candidate will bring a collaborative leadership style, with the ability to advocate, negotiate, communicate and problem solve in a complex, multidisciplinary environment, with and among board members, family physicians, health care practitioners and community partners. This position demands a highly organized individual with over five years of progressive leadership experience, who brings interpersonal, financial, governance and strategic planning acumen to the Division table along with a degree in a relevant program area (including, but not limited to, healthcare and / or not-for-profit leadership). This position will model the organization's commitment to working with their indigenous partners in the spirit of reconciliation and sharing a commitment in the journey towards cultural safety and humility. A combination of education, competencies, and experience will also be considered.

The salary for this position is \$135,000 – \$150,000 supplemented by a competitive total compensation package.
