FULL-TIME TENURE-TRACK POSITION IN THE FIELD OF NUTRITION AND POPULATION HEALTH

The School of Nutrition of Université Laval invites applications for a full-time tenure-track faculty position in the field of nutrition and population health (no. 64834). Université Laval is located in beautiful Quebec City, a UNESCO World Heritage city and capital of the province of Quebec, Canada. With more than 40,000 students, the University is a stimulating working and living environment, in the heart of a metropolitan community of 800,000 inhabitants.

JOB DESCRIPTION

1. Conduct and publish research in the area of public health nutrition and food environment policies;
2. Apply for funding from national and international granting agencies;
3. Contribute to teaching in nutrition programs at all three cycles, including topics related to food systems and public health policies in nutrition;
4. Recruit and supervise graduate students and postdoctoral trainees;
5. Participate in the development and outreach of Université Laval School of Nutrition.

SELECTION CRITERIA

1. Hold a PhD in nutrition or public health or a related discipline;
2. Have a recognized expertise in the field of nutrition and population health;
3. Have a competitive scientific record for national granting agencies as demonstrated by recent high scientific productivity and obtaining scholarships, grants or significant awards.
4. Have demonstrated teamwork ability;
5. Have experience in university teaching and student supervision;
6. Be able to teach in French or commit to do so within two years.
